WHAT THESE SCHEMES DO

Government support that lowers the cost of doing business

Haryana's industrial and MSME schemes provide financial assistance as subsidies, reimbursements, exemptions and concessions. They aim to cut business costs, attract investment, create local jobs and support balanced growth across the state's blocks.

Who can benefit from these schemes

1 New industrial units

Enterprises starting commercial production in Haryana.

2 Expanding units

Existing units doing eligible expansion, diversification or tech upgrade.

3 MSMEs

Micro, small & medium units registered via Udyam and HUM.

4 Recognised startups

DPIIT-recognised startups where the startup scheme applies.

5 Rural micro units

Micro manufacturing enterprises outside municipal limits.

6 Exporters & thrust sectors

Exporting, innovation and thrust-sector enterprises.

Types of assistance available

Investment subsidy (Net SGST)

Refund of a share of Net SGST paid, by block and ceiling.

Capital subsidy

Support on eligible building, plant & machinery investment.

Interest subsidy

Part of interest on eligible term loans, for a fixed period.

Employment generation

Per-employee assistance for Haryana-resident workers.

Electricity & power relief

Duty exemption and tariff concession on industrial power.

Stamp duty & EDC relief

Refund or exemption of eligible land-related charges.

Quality, patent & export

Reimbursement for certification, patents, tech and exports.

Investment Subsidy in lieu of Net SGST

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

MSMEs launching a new manufacturing unit or expanding in Blocks B, C or D of Haryana (expansion needs a minimum 50% additional investment in plant & machinery).

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- Block D: 75% of Net SGST for 7 years, then 35% for 3 years (cap 150% of FCI).
- Block C: 75% for 7 years, then 35% for 3 years (cap 125% of FCI).
- Block B: 50% for 5 years, then 25% for 3 years (cap 100% of FCI).

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RURAL · CAPITAL

Rural Industrial Development Scheme (HGUY)

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

New micro manufacturing enterprises located outside municipal limits, in rural areas under Blocks B, C and D.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- Capital subsidy: 15% on building and plant & machinery, up to Rs.15 lakh (up to Rs.25 lakh for Women / SC / ST entrepreneurs).
- Interest subsidy: 6% per annum on term loans, up to Rs.8 lakh per year for 5 years.

MSME Interest Subsidy Scheme

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Newly established Micro and Small Enterprises that have availed term loans from public or private banks (account must not turn NPA).

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- Blocks C & D: 5% interest subvention, up to Rs.10 lakh per year for 5 years.
- Block B: 5% interest subvention, up to Rs.10 lakh per year for 3 years.

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EMPLOYMENT

Employment Generation Subsidy Scheme

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Industrial units in Blocks B, C and D employing workers who are permanent residents of Haryana, with active PF and ESI registration.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- General category workers: Rs.30,000 per employee per year, for 5 to 7 years.
- SC / Women / Marginalised workers: Rs.36,000 per employee per year, for 5 to 7 years.

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POWER · ENERGY

Electricity Duty Exemption & Power Tariff Concession

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

All new manufacturing industrial units in selected blocks, on connections matching the industrial registration identity.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- 100% electricity duty exemption: 10 years (Block D), 7 years (Block C), 5 years (Block B).
- Power tariff concession of Rs.2 per unit for a fixed period, as per prevailing notification.

Patent Registration Subsidy Scheme

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

MSMEs with active operations in Haryana; the patent must be in the name of the enterprise, its promoters or directors. Claimed on reimbursement basis after grant.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- Domestic patents: 100% of actual costs (filing, examination, attorney fees) up to Rs.25 lakh per patent.
- International patents: 100% of registration costs up to Rs.25 lakh per patent.
- Claimable for multiple distinct patents.



QUALITY

Quality Certification Assistance Scheme

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

All functioning MSMEs in active commercial production in Haryana, not on the state's restrictive list. Apply online within 3 months of certification.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- 75% of the total certification expenditure reimbursed.
- Maximum ceiling of Rs.1 lakh.
- Covers ISO, HACCP, BSI, WHO-GMP, ZED, TS and Hallmark.

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TECHNOLOGY

Assistance for Technology Acquisition Scheme

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

New and existing MSMEs in regular commercial production, acquiring technology from a recognised national/international institute or authorised provider.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- 50% of the total technology acquisition cost reimbursed.
- Covers designs/drawings, technology development fees, and R&D or technical consultancy fees.

Stamp Duty Refund Scheme

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

New and expanding units across Micro to Ultra-Mega categories in respect of land purchased

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- General category: 100% refund (Block D), 75% (Block C), 60% (Block B).
- Thrust sectors & bio-energy: 100% (Blocks C & D), 80% (Block B).
- Data centres: 100% refund across the entire state.
- Service Sectors: 50% (Blocks C & D), 30% (Block A)

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EXPORTS

Freight Assistance Scheme

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

New exporting units (exports commenced on or after 01.01.2017) directly exporting their own manufactured goods, with valid IEC and export council membership.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- 1% of FOB value of the export consignment, or actual freight paid, whichever is lower.
- Up to Rs.20 lakh per year (Blocks C & D); up to Rs. 10 lakh per year (Blocks A & B).
- Thrust Sectors: Up to Rs.25 lakh per year (Blocks C & D); up to Rs. 15 lakh per year (Blocks A & B).
- Available for up to 5 years from the date exports begin.

External Development Charges (EDC) Exemption

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

New enterprises that commenced commercial production on or after 01.01.2021, with valid URC, HUM and CLU/NOC where applicable.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- General (Large, MSME, Thrust, Agro): 60% (Block B), 75% (Block C), 100% (Block D).
- ESDM & Import Substitution: 100% exemption across Blocks B, C and D.
- Essential sector enterprises: 100% in Blocks B and C.

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STARTUPS

Assistance for Startups in Haryana

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

DPIIT-recognised startups registered on the state portal (URC & HUM). Seed grant may be availed pre-production; other benefits need active operation.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- 8% interest subsidy up to Rs.20 lakh per year for 5 years; 100% Net SGST reimbursement for 7 years (cap 150% of FCI).
- Seed grant up to Rs.10 lakh; lease rental 30% (45% for women-only founders).
- Cloud computing and acceleration-programme support.

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ENERGY

Renewable Energy Projects Scheme

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

All new enterprises (Micro to Ultra-Mega) established anywhere in Haryana; unit must be in regular production at the time of disbursement.

BENEFIT AVAILABLE

- Captive solar (above 1 MW) and bio-energy projects are treated as 'Industry' and get all Thrust Sector incentives under HEEP-2020.
- Dedicated bio-energy capital subsidy of 25%, up to Rs.1 crore per MW (maximum Rs.2.5 crore).

Other schemes worth knowing

Testing Equipment Assistance

Subsidy on specialised laboratory testing instruments for product quality.

Industry–Academia Research

Aid up to Rs.50 lakh per project for joint research leading to commercialisation.

Energy Conservation

Up to 75% (max Rs.2 lakh) for energy audits, plus support for rooftop solar.

Water Conservation

Offsets cost of waste-water recycling, rainwater harvesting and zero-liquid discharge.

Environment & Waste Management

Assistance for effluent treatment plants and industrial waste systems.

Market Development Assistance

Up to 75% of exhibition space (max Rs.3 lakh) plus economy airfare for trade fairs.

How to claim — key conditions & documents

KEY CONDITIONS

- Hold valid registrations — Udyam (URC), Haryana Udhyam Memorandum, GST and other approvals.
- Be in eligible commercial production, unless the scheme allows pre-production (seed) support.
- Match the scheme's block, sector, investment and category; stay off the state's negative list.
- Apply online within the prescribed deadline and keep operating for the minimum period.

COMMON DOCUMENTS

- Udyam Registration Certificate and Haryana Udhyam Memorandum.
- Incorporation / partnership / proprietorship papers and board resolution.
- Project report, CA-certified investment details and machinery invoices.
- GST filings, loan and interest documents, and land / stamp-duty records.
- Scheme-specific proofs — patents, certificates, shipping bills, BRCs, etc.

Turn eligibility into benefit

Confirm your block category, check that your sector and investment qualify, prepare a complete document file, and submit each claim within the deadline through the designated online portal.

Always verify the latest official notification before applying.
